RESOLUTION 2019-5-5**

**RESOLUTION TO CANCEL TAXES DUE TO VETERAN EXEMPTION
FOR 6 GLOCK FARM WAY KNOWN AS BLOCK 202.26 LOT 3
AND AUTHORIZE REFUND OF OVERPAYMENT**

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 54:4-3.30A allows for the exemption from taxation from real and personal property for any citizen and resident of the State who has a total or 100% permanent disability as defined by this statute; and

WHEREAS, John Franklin Knipe III owns the property located at 6 Glock Farm Way known as Block 202.26 Lot 3 and recorded in deed dated June 27, 2018; and

WHEREAS, John Franklin Knipe II is a 100% disabled Veteran; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Knipe III has completed form D.V.S.S.E. and provided the documentary proofs required to the Tax Assessor; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Assessor has reviewed and approved the Veteran Exemption effective March 3, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Lereta Tax Services has continued to pay the property taxes creating an overpayment in the amount of \$3,796.45.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Committee of the Township of Chesterfield, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, hereby approves the veteran exemption on Block 202.26 Lot 3 effective March 3, 2019 and thereafter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Tax Collector is hereby authorized to cancel 2019 taxes in the amount of \$3,796.45 and issue refund to Lereta in the amount of \$3,796.45 representing overpayments created by granting the veteran exemption.
