WHEREAS, the Township Committee believes it is in the best interest of the public to fulfill the vacancy; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police and Township Administrator recommend the appointment of Peter P. Bell; and

WHEREAS, Peter Bell possesses all of the qualifications required by State Statute and Township Ordinance; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Chesterfield in the County of Burlington and State of New Jersey that Peter P. Bell is hereby appointed as full-time Police Officer for the Township of Chesterfield, effective December 1, 2022; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Peter P. Bell is hired at Step 1 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Township of Chesterfield and the Chesterfield Police FOP Lodge 114, Fraternal Order of Police/New Jersey Labor Council;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this appointment is subject to the probationary period outlined in Chapter 42 Section 8A(1) of the Code of the Township of Chesterfield.
