**WHEREAS**, Cody Wilson was appointed as a part-time Special Police Officer by Resolution 2022-1-22 with an effective date of January 3, 2022; and

**WHEREAS**, Patrolman Kevin Scheuren resigned effective December 26, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has requested the Township Committee appoint part-time Officer Cody Wilson to a full-time Police Officer; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Committee believes it is in the best interest of the public to fulfill the vacancy; and

**WHEREAS**, Cody Wilson possesses all of the qualifications required by State Statute and Township Ordinance; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Committee of the Township of Chesterfield in the County of Burlington and State of New Jersey that Cody Wilson is hereby appointed as full-time Police Officer for the Township of Chesterfield, effective March 1, 2022; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Cody Wilson is hired at Step 1 of the Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Township of Chesterfield and the Chesterfield Police FOP Lodge 114, Fraternal Order of Police/New Jersey Labor Council;

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this appointment is subject to the probationary period outlined in Chapter 42 Section 8A(1) of the Code of the Township of Chesterfield, waiver of Class II to full certification.
