**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REJECTION OF THE BID(S)
RECEIVED FOR THE OLIVIA PARK GAZEBO/CRICKET PITCH DUGOUT
PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Township of Chesterfield had authorized the advertisement of bids to be received for the Oliva Park Gazebo and Cricket Pitch Dugout Project (“Project”); and,

WHEREAS, bids were opened as advertised for the Project on May 29, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, one (1) sealed bid was received from the following vendor:

WHEREAS, Environmental Resolutions, Inc., the Township Engineer, has reviewed the bid submission and has found that the sole bid proposal received has exceeded the Township’s appropriation for the goods and services, as well as the Engineer’s original cost estimate of the Project; and,

WHEREAS, the Township Committee is satisfied that the sole proposal submitted has substantially exceeded the Township’s appropriation for goods and services as well as the Engineer’s original cost estimate for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Chesterfield in the County of Burlington and State of New Jersey that in regard to the bid proposal submission received for the above referenced Project, based upon the recommendations of the Township’s Engineer and Attorney, that the Township hereby authorizes the rejection of the bid proposal submission(s) received pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-13.2(a) and 40A:11-13.2(b), as the proposals all substantially exceed the Township’s appropriation for goods and services as well as the Engineer’s original cost estimate for the project.
