PUBLIC COMMENTS PERTAINING TO MATTERS ON THE AGENDA

Ms. Koetas-Dale made a motion to open to public seconded by Ms. Blazic. All were in favor.

Sherri Dudas – 258 Ellisdale Road – She stated she had a conversation with Ms. Koetas-Dale regarding the ordinance for introduction and whether it would be allowed on preserved farms. She stated it is clear that farms preserved through the traditional preservation programs would not be permitted to grow cannabis. The question remains whether it would be allowed on TDR preserved farms. She suggested the attorney review to interpret. She had sent Ms. Koetas-Dale a letter she received from the SADC. Ms. Koetas-Dale stated she did not send to the rest of the committee because our attorney had already indicated it would not be allowed on preserved farms. Mr. Sahol replied that the ordinance for introduction would not allow cannabis on preserved farms no matter the method of preservation.

She stated the ordinance prohibits it from being grown on preserved farms and that is a mistake. She stated that is in violation of the Right to Farm Act.
